Sub.: Regarding Action Plan of TEQIP III faculty and vacant faculty position at CTAE, Udaipur.

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your letter No. 11 (4) r f"k. /2001 dt. 25.01.2018 regarding vacant position of faculty at the Institute and faculty members deputed by NPIU, New Delhi under TEQIP III against sanctioned vacant positions.

The College of Technology and Engineering, Udaipur is a constituent College of Maharana Pratap Universty of Agriculture and Technology. The college offers UG and PG programs in various branches of Engineering.

The TEQIP-III project is operational in 90 Engineering Institutions in the country. The NBA accredited programmes in all these Engineering Institutions is 45 in number. Out of these 45 NBA accredited programme, 10 UG & PG programme of CTAE are NBA accredited, 22 % of the country.

In response to meeting agenda, the Institute response are given as follows.

## 1. UG Programmes (07 Nos)

## (a) AICTE Approval

The seven AICTE approved programmes offered at UG level are – Agricultural Engineering (AE), Civil Engineering (CE), Mining Engineering (MiE), Mechanical Engineering (ME), Electrical Engineering (EE), Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) and Computer Science and Engineering (CSE).

# (b) NBA Accreditation

Out of the seven (7) UG approved programme by AICTE, five (5) programme are NBA accredited. Further, UG programme of ECE & CSE are in the process of NBA accreditation.

#### 2. PG Programmes (7 No.)

#### (a) AICTE approval

Out of the seven (7 No.) PG programmes, four (4 No.) are AICTE approved and for remaining three (3 No.), institution has applied for AICTE approval from the session 2018-19.

#### (b) NBA Accreditation

As far the NBA accreditation is concern, the discipline of Agricultural Engineering is having four (4 No.) specialization and all four (4 No.) are NBA accredited till June, 2019. In addition to this, the PG programme of Electrical Engineering is also accredited by NBA till June, 2019. Five (5 No.) PG programmes are require NBA accreditation.

### 3. Faculty Position

## (a) Assistant Professors (58 Non plan sanctioned positions)

Out of the 58 non-plan positions of Assistant Professor, 29 are filled and 29 are lying vacant.

NPIU has filled sixteen (16) positions of Assistant Professors (Gen-11, OBC-3 and Sc-2) on contract basis and seven (7 No.) positions of Assistant Professor are in process at NPIU level for filling up. The six (6 No.) positions of Agricultural Engineering related discipline, NPIU is not processing to fill up.

Out of the 29 vacant positions of Assistant Professor, State Government has given permission to fill up eleven (11 No.) positions in the year 2017-18. Remaining eighteen (18 No.) non-plan positions of Assistant Professor will be filled up in the year 2019-20 with the permission of State Government.

Note: For AICTE approval and NBA accreditation, sixteen (16 No.) more Assistant Professors are required and these positions are filled by guest faculty / contractual faculty.

## (b) Associate Professor (15 Non plan sanctioned positions)

Out of the fifteen non-plan positions of Associate Professor, eight (8 No.) are filled up and seven (7 No.) are vacant. Out of the seven vacant positions, we have sent six (6 No.) positions of Associate Professor to be fill up by NPIU.

This will full fill our requirement for AICTE approval and NBA accreditation of UG and PG programme.

## (c) Professors (7 Non plan sanctioned positions)

Out of the seven (7 No.) positions of Professors, one position is filled up and for four (4 No.) positions we have requested NPIU to fill up for AICTE approval and remaining NBA accreditation.

# 4. Regularisation of Assistant Professors (Contract) of NPIU, MHRD, New Delhi.

Presently sixteen (16 No.) Assistant Professor (on contract) are working and seven (07) are in process of recruitment by NPIU.

The Assistant Professors appointed by NPIU, MHRD, New Delhi are recruited through national level advertisement and highly qualified, having at least one degree from IIT or NIT and full fills the requirement of qualification as per AICTE norms, as well as norms of the University.

The Assistant Professors are giving good outcome and their teaching methodology is very much liked by the students. This will also improve the academic environment and placement scenario of the institute.

Therefore looking to the quality of Assistant Professor (on contract) and interest of the institution, the procedure may be evolved in consultation with National Project Implementation Unit, MHRD, New Delhi to absorb these faculty in the Institution against vacant non-plan positions.
