- Full length papers, should be inclusive of Title, Authors name and affiliations, Authors contact information, Orcid id of the corresponding author, Abstract (300-400 words), Keywords and References
- Posters should be sent by registered post or by hand
- A brief resume of the author should accompany the Abstract.

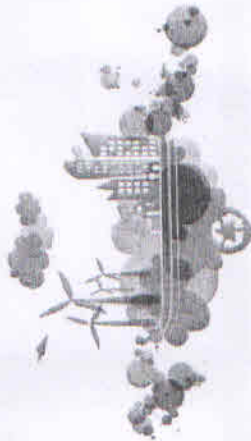
