## **ADSW's Report**

In the New Year, Annual Festival of Sir Padampat Singhania University, Panache was organized at their campus from 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2012, a team of 4 students participated in various events and Mr. Pranay Pathak III (Ag.) has won I prize of Rs. 5000/- in English speech. A team of 4 students from CTAE have participated in Inter University debate competition held at G.B. Pant University, Pantnagar from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2012. Mr. Mritunjay Kumar Jha, III CSE won II prize and a cash prize of Rs. 2000/- on all India bases. The participation of team was also appreciated by Judges.

A special camp to register the name of students in the Electoral list by district authority was organized on 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2012 in the Seminar Hall of CTAE, and 23 students have registered their names. A very prestigious and special function, Convocation of CTAE & CDFST was held on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2012, the Chief guest for the function was Dr. Ashok K Chauhan (Founder President of AMITY Group of Education). I year Instructional Block was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Dr. Ashok K Chauhan and President was Dr. Narendra S Rathore, Dean, CTAE. A team of students participated in IGNUS 2012, cultural festival organized by IIT Rajasthan, Jodhpur from 16<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2012 and won two individual prizes. A well awaited cultural fest of CTAE, **Neurofest 2012** was organized from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 in the college and auditorium. Almost 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the total strength of the students participated in 18 different events with full of zeal.
